Lovely entry of 99 dogs making 110 entries.

The Committee put on a cracking well run show, with super prizes for Exhibitors. Thank you for the hospitality shown to us on the day and for the lovely gifts.

Vintage Dog(1) 1st – Tollan's Anasmas Amalegend, 11 years and looking well. Ok head, eye a little large. Decent body, moved freely.

Veteran Dog (6) 1st – Tollan's Souska Precious to me for Anasmas, moved best in this class, preferred his head over others. Good rib and topline. 2nd Stevenson's Tamrae Time Lord at Amadrew, lovely to judge him again, shown in good order, just preferred ones head and expression. 3rd – Wilson's Rosanley Phoenix at Lymehills,

MPD (2) 1st – Johnstone's Tuyet Bunn Aha Bhain, very pleasing pup good head and cushioning. Decent fill to body holding backline with good tailset, moved straight and free, good prospect. 2nd Taylors Oldcharm Can you love me at Maursett, another promising pup, just slightly more dome to skull at present, tidy active mover and clean positive footfall.

PD (2) 1st – Lemon's Parloueve Made you Look, cracking youngster, so assertive and thoroughly enjoying himself. Lovely head with correct eye and ear, correct cushioning. Moderate bone with correct foot. Good spring to rib, moderate in stifle, clean coming and going and correct backline and outlook in profile. RCC, BPIS.

JD (3) 1st – Gilling's Talocan Heart of Eternity, preferred head and expression. More typical in outlook and moved cleanly. 2nd Morton's Linsdown Gibran, not as clean in front and preferred ones head. 3rd Tollan's Rosanley Tavernier to Anasmas

YD (5) 1st – Smith's Torfness Gamekeepers Vigil, lovely type, well balanced and quick free mover with good foot fall. Show in good order and decent fill to body. 2nd Thomsons Tibbiestars Time Lord JW, close up, a lot to like also, just felt one was more in the room today, pleasing example and tidy mover. 3rd Prouve & Moran's Castafiore Invictus

Grad (1) 1st – Harlow/Birkett/McDowall's Souska Nothin but the Best, ok head and expression, correct bone and ok feet, slightly lower in tailset, moved ok.

Post Grad (3) 1st – Gilling's Kentone Epsilon of Talocan, good head and expression with correct cushioning, good bone and fill to chest, moderate stifle and clean behind. Moved out freely and cleanly.

Limit Dog (11) 1st – Campbell's Teindland Macduff, preferred his outlook and balance compared to others. Nicely proportioned head with good eye and ear, decent cushioning. Held topline and good tailset and carriage. Clean quick mover, shown in good order. 2nd – Campbell's Tulibell Neville Longbottom, close up just preferred head of one, clean mover and well shown. 3rd – Bruce's Betranna Aramis,

Open Dog (7) 1st – Tollan's New Idea New Start Lucy's Secret (Imp Cze), moved best in this class, good balance with a proudly carried head, decent expression. Shown in good order, pleasing dog. 2nd – Harlow/Croft-Elliots/Acker/McDowall's Am Ch Maciain Goodspice Live and Let Die, I liked his outlook and style but was not in the room today, was a little sluggish and did not have that verve, pity. 3rd Campbell's Teindland MacDuff,

Spec Bred by Exh (1) 1st Tuyet Bunn Aha Bhain, moved ok not as balanced as other, ok head.

Spec Not bred by Exh (3) 1st Christie's Betranna Athos, was reserve in limit, moved best here, decent head ok expression. 2nd Brown's Torfness Cassius Clay, reserve in veteran, not so happy today and was sluggish.

Spec Colour A Particolour Dog (1) 1st – Irvine's Susu Life of the Parti,

Spec Colour B Black Tan Dog (2) 1st – Souska Precious to me for Anasmas. 2nd – Anasmas Amalegend.

Champion Dog (3) – 1st Prouve/Moran's Ch Xaramae Image (Imp Fin), topped a very good class. Lovely masculine dog in full bloom, well balanced and ticked the boxes today. Super head and expression with correct eye and ear with correct cushioning. Well-made throughout, clean behind and good footfall coming and going. Had that outlook and style in profile could not be denied the CC and BIS. 2nd – Lemon's Ch Parloueve True Blue, another masculine male of super quality, moving well. 3rd – Morton's Ch Linsdown Jai, made a lovely trio and a pleasure to judge them all.

Vintage Bitch (2) 1st – Campbells Tibbymills Ace of Hearts ShCM, Vw, lovely quality really enjoying her day, still as sound as a pound and in good order. 2nd Thomson's Ch Tamrae Talking Point JW, another lovely bitch, just not as clean when moving today, delighted to see her.

Veteran Bitch (5) 1st - Cooper & Obrien's Ch Susu Princess Spice Parti JW Vw W17, super quality and what a personality. Loved her head and expression, so well balanced a smidgen away in the challenge. Best Veteran in Show. 2nd – Ch Torfness Scarlet Phancy, lovely type just not as clean moving today. 3rd Coughtrie's Tulibell Star Struck with Jazpiper,

- PB (4) 1st Lemon's Parloueve Love me Better, 3 nice pups all at differing stages, 1 so happy and full of spirit, lovely feminine head, good cushioning, clean active mover, good prospect. 2nd- Prouve & Moran's Enaya Vom Dach Der Welt, needs time but has promise, moved ok. 3rd Harlow's Birkcross Hilda Ogden, another pleasing pup, another just need time to balance.
- JB (2) 1st Campbell's Rosanley Aaliyah, preferred her outlook and movement, decent head and expression, and fill to body. Shown in good order. 2nd Harlow/Beckett/McDowall's Birkcross Bettys Hotspot, not as balanced as my winner but a pleasing type.
- YB (3) good class, 3 nice bitches 1st Thomson/Prentice's Tamrae Parti with the Stars, super quality in this class, loved her head and expression with good eye and ear and correct cushioning. Good feet and bone and nicely filled and angled behind. Clean positive mover. Well balanced which in her profile movement another seriously considered. 2nd Hamilton's Torfness Hollie day Romance of Galetibbian, another lovely girl, similar comments apply, I was splitting hairs. Pleasure to handle. Smith's Torfness White Witches Kiss
- GB (5) 1st Abercrombie's Tibwood Tells our Story JW, loved her head and expression, with good cushioning and super balance throughout. Tidy mover, will go far. Gilling's Princess Mulan Iiharess of Talocan, another nice bitch just not as clean behind. Clements Tulibell Diva Pawtrol,
- PGB (9) 1st Campbell's Tulibell Bad Habits JW, Loved her style and outlook and so well balanced. Lovely feminine head and expression with good eye and ear and good cushioning. Good feet and bone and well made all through. Good clean quick mover, holding topline and was in super condition, she pulled out all the stops to get RCC. 2nd Smith's Torfness Phancy Kisses, another very pleasing feminine bitch, with a lovely head, felt one had the edge on balance and movement today, nice to handle. 3rd Cooper/Obrien's Susu Parti like a Rockstar, has quality but lacked body and coat today.
- LB (11) Campbells Teindland Strathisla, typical well-balanced bitch with all the essentials, good fill to body and clean positive movement. Shown in good order. 2nd Tollan's Anasmas Godiva, lovely type with very pleasing heads and expression just not as balanced or had that edge on movement. 3rd Harlow/Birkett/McDowell's Torfness Dancing Queen
- OB (5) 1st Smith's Torfness Fire and Blood, Super head and expression, well-made but feminine throughout. Sound as a pond and just had that balance and panache that screamed me today delighted to award her the CC, in strong Company. 2nd Place/Halliday's Ch Susu Wears Prada in Lockdown at Aarminias, another that appealed greatly but was not moving as well as my winner, very pleasing bitch to handle and in good order. 3rd Wilson's Tulibell Cinder Ella with Torfness

Spec Bred by Exh Bitch (3) 1st Campbells Tulibell Su Pryze Parti JW, well-balanced and typical with quick positive movement and in good order. 2nd Kerr's Vonvue Mythical Queen, not as clean in head as other moved ok. 3rd Kerr's Vonvue Goodness Misha.

Spec Not Bred Exh Bitch (3) 1^{st} – Abercrombie's Ravenways Don't Let go for Tibwood, lovely girl with a pleasing head and expression with correct eye and ear. Decent feet and front and has good fill to body. Moved cleanly and was in good order. 2^{nd} – Torfness Desert Queen, decent fill to body moved ok. 3^{rd} – Tulibell Monty's Girl.

Spec Colour B Black Tan Bitch – Tollan's Betranna Ara Minta, moved best in this class, decent fill to body. 2nd Bruces Betranna At-Lanta, carrying too much weight which reflected in her movement. 3rd Johnstone's Tuyet's Charlotti Boo

Champion Bitch (2) 1st Prouve & Moran's Ch Castafiore Riddhima, very pleasing feminine bitch full of quality and well balanced throughout. In the challenge felt she lacked that sparkle to take her all the way. Clean positive mover. 2nd Adams Ch Balgay Okurimono, lovely head and expression, carrying too much weight which spoilt her balance and outline, but has quality throughout.

Breeders – Smith's Torfness – well matched and moved well.
